Cash for disabled children on offer

IW-BASED organisations are being encouraged to apply for funding to help provide fun-filled activities for disabled children.

Current changes to the way the government allocates funding for short breaks means organisations can approach IW Council with proposals for activities.

Short breaks are essentially activities disabled children go on, perhaps for an afternoon or even a few hours at the

weekend, providing them with fun-based activities while also giving the child's carers, such as their family or guardian, time off.

Grants of £2,500 up to £120,000 are available to organisations to help provide activities.

Organisations that feel they may be able to offer short breaks are asked to contact the council via e-mail to aiminghigh@iow.gov.uk

Submissions should be sent in by April 23.

The funding is available under the government's Aiming High for Disabled Children programme, which aims, in particular, to improve the short break opportunities for those children with the most severe and complex disabilities.

Tip-off led to drug in attic discovery

AN ARGUMENT with his partner cost an IW College student £200 in court fines, after she tipped off the police about his cannabis stash.

David John Rolf, 26, of Winford Road, Newchurch, pleaded guilty to producing cannabis, when he appeared before Island magistrates.

Following a call from his

partner, officers discovered 12 plants in the attic at his home, which Rolf was cultivating for personal use, said Tracy Connors, prosecuting.

Oscar Vincent, defending, said it was the first and last time his client would attempt to grow cannabis.

Rolf, who had no previous convictions, was fined £100 with £85 costs and a £15 surcharge.

Plan refusal praised

THE IW Council received a rare pat on the back from Ryde Town Council.

Members of the authority's planning committee were praised for going against officer recommendation and turning down an application for a house close to an ancient oak tree.

Opponents of building near the 200-year-old Buckland Oak, off Spencer Road, included town council planning chairman Tim Wakeley, who said IW Council members should be applauded for their stance. The application was refused because councillors decided development would harm the appearance of the oak and the area.

Mrs Margaret Hampton



MUSICIAN, gardener and well known Island businesswoman, Margaret Hampton, has died, aged 88.

Mrs Hampton, who lived in Shalfleet, was born in Newport and was the eldest daughter of greengrocer and subpostmaster of Coppins Bridge, Arthur Dore.

She was educated at Westwing School, Ryde, before joining her father's business.

From here, she went on to drive ambulances during the Second World War, transferring patients to and from hospital.

She married IW florist and nurseryman Peter Hampton and they had two children, Chris and Simon.

Chris lives in Devon and Simon lives in Northumberland.

Margaret opened a newsagents in Newport and combined this with her role as a music teacher, firstly at Swainston House and then at various primary schools on the Island, including All Saints', Freshwater, St Thomas of Canterbury, Carisbrooke, and Gatten and Lake, Shanklin.

She was an accomplished pianist and a regular contributor to the IW Musical Competition Festival.

Her interest in gardening blossomed after her husband died in 1992.

Margaret was a member of the IW Gardens Trust and her garden at her Shalfleet home was opened regularly for the public, to enjoy the vast array of flowers and plants.

Her funeral takes place on Monday at All Saints' Church, Calbourne.
